If the Owner requests to meet with the Board, the Board shall make a reasonable effort to comply with the Owner's request.

Disputes may be submitted to arbitration before the Colorado Springs Board of Realtors for resolution in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association at the election of any party and upon providing notice of election to the other party pursuant to Article XII, Section 12.2 of the Declaration.

Neither the Association nor the Owner waives any right to pursue whatever legal or other remedial actions available to either party.
